



Vim Editor: Essential Commands

Insert Mode

- * `i` - Enter Insert mode at the cursor
- * `I` - Enter Insert mode at the beginning of the line
- * `a` - Append after the cursor
- * `A` - Append at the end of the line
- * `o` - Open a new line below the current line
- * `O` - Open a new line above the current line
- * `Esc` - Exit Insert mode

Cursor Movement

- * `h` - Move left
- * `j` - Move down
- * `k` - Move up
- * `l` - Move right
- * `w` - Move to the beginning of the next word
- * `b` - Move to the beginning of the previous word
- * `$` - Move to the end of the line
- * `gg` - Move to the first line of the document
- * `G` - Move to the last line of the document

Search

- * `/pattern` - Search forward for 'pattern'
- * `?pattern` - Search backward for 'pattern'
- * `n` - Move to the next occurrence
- * `N` - Move to the previous occurrence
- * `:s/old/new` - Replace 'old' with 'new' on the current line
- * `:%s/old/new/g` - Replace 'old' with 'new' globally in the file

Deletion

- * `x` - Delete character under the cursor
- * `dd` - Delete the current line
- * `yy` - Copy the current line
- * `p` - Paste the copied or deleted content
- * `u` - Undo the last change
- * `Ctrl+r` - Redo the last change

Saving

- * `:w` - Save the changes
- * `:q` - Quit Vim
- * `:wq` - Save the changes and quit
- * `:q!` - Quit without saving changes

Advanced

- * `.` - Repeat the last command
- * `:%s/old/new/gc` - Replace 'old' with 'new' globally
- * `:set number` - Display line numbers
- * `:set nonumber` - Hide line numbers
- * `:set syntax=language` - Set syntax highlighting for a specific language

Advanced

- * `~/.vimrc` - Vim configuration file
- * `:map key command` - Create a custom key mapping
- * `:colorscheme scheme_name` - Set a specific colorscheme
- * `:set option` - Enable a specific option
- * `:set nooption` - Disable a specific option
